## Eligible Gliders, season 2007/2008

This list is intended to conform with the gliders permitted in International Club Class at the time of the competition. At this time, the range of European handicaps included is from .96 to 1.07. The list has been reduced for simplicity, to only include gliders known to be normally flying in Australia and included in the Australian Handicap List.

Should any pilot wish to enter Club Class in a glider eligible for International Club Class which is not in this list, it will be permitted. The Handicap Committee will need to determine the appropriate handicap and reference weight that will apply.

If a glider is not in the IGC List, it can be added to the Australian eligibility list with the approval of the NCC, provided that its performance lies within the range of glider performances already in the list.
