## GFA AD 34 REFERENCES GFA HEMP CORE CABLE REQUIRMENTS

## **GFA AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE**

TYPE AFFECTED: All new gliders imported with hemp cored cables.

SUBJECT: Exemption against replacement of hemp cored cables under MAR

1 up to a total time in service of 300 hours.

BACKGROUND: The initial issue of this AD allowed operation of certain glider

types to a total of 300 hours from new before replacing the hemp cored cables. This issue extends this to cover all new glider

imported with hemp cored cables.

Note: All second had gliders imported with hemp cored cables must have the cables replaced before flying in Australia unless it

has less than 300 flight hours.

ACTION REQUIRED: All gliders imported with hemp cored cables must have the cables

replaced before reaching 300 hours total time in service.

Any gliders imported with more than 300 flight hours must have

the cables replaced before flying in Australia.

WEIGHT AND BALANCE: Not affected.

IMPLEMENTATION: Replacement of cables must be performed by the holder of a

DA1109 Glider Inspectors Certificate rated for Issue of

Maintenance Releases any type.

COMPLIANCE: The requirements of this GFA Airworthiness Directive are

mandatory. This Directive is issued pursuant to the Rules and

Regulations of the Gliding Federation of Australia.
