Answers to a list of technical questions posed to the Czechoslovakian Aviation Authorities have been received and are being evaluated to asses a "befs life" under typical Australian operating conditions. This assessment will take time but a preliminary assessment does not offer encouragement that any great extension of safe life will be justifiable. It is known that fatigue testing of a Blanik L-73 glider and components was undertaken and that failures occurred. evaluated to assess

These fatigus tests were a basis for the initial safe life of 3000 hrs of 15,000 haunches determined by the Czechoslovakian Authorities; basis for the extension of safe life set out in Bulletin L-13/045 is mainly on the basis that average operating conditions are less severe than the assumed loading spectrum initially used.

to appears, however, that the best prospect for any effective increase to the economic safe life of L-13 Blanik gliders rests with the possibility of replacement of fatigue prone assemblies. It should be recognized that the above view reflects the opinion of the G.F.A. Chief Technical Officer Airworthiness as did the comments in Airworthiness Advice Notice Ref. No. GFA/AN/27 Kunovice 4. however,
