Glider Type Affected:

Rolladen Schneider L.S.1F

Background:

Wing root fillet fairings for L.S.1F gliders were intended to be secured using pressure sensitive adhesive tape; operational experience has shown this method of fixing to be unreliable and has been rejected by the L.B.A. in Germany, Rolladen Schneider Technical Bulletin No. 28 refers.

Required Action:

The use of wing root fillet fairings secured by the use of adhesive tape is similarly banned in Australia. Rolladen Schneider is investigating a more satisfactory means of fixing and also conducting an investigation into the aerodynamic benefit of the fairings.

Sheet 6/9.5.75 is to be removed from the operating manual and the index reference to be crossed off the list of contents.

Compliance:

The requirement of this directive is mandatory.

This directive is issued pursuant to the Air Navigation Regulations under the delegated authority of the Secretary of the Department of Transport.
