	<ul> <li>Bulletin 06. The envelope restrictions from AD 107 were retained.</li> <li>GFA AD's 130 and 131 mandated further inspection and repair IAW Service Bulletins 07 and 08. At the completion of <b>BOTH</b> AD 130 and AD 131, the envelope restrictions can be removed.</li> <li>Issue 2 of this AD clarifies that the envelope restrictions can be removed by completing both AD 130 and AD 131.</li> </ul>

Required Action(s)	1. Carry out inspections IAW FFA Service Bulletin 06 (Enclosed).
	Apply a red mark on the airspeed indicator at 90 knots using instrument decal, marking tape or similar. Apply a red placard to the airspeed indicator as shown in Figure 1.
	Create a new cockpit placard detailing the envelope restrictions as per paragraph 3 of FFA Service Bulletin 06.
	Enter a minor defect into the maintenance release stating "AD114 Issue 2 Action 2 not carried out – Aircraft operating under restricted envelope".
	At each Annual Inspection the minor defect is to be entered into the new maintenance release. The cockpit placard, ASI decal and airspeed indicator mark should be inspected for adhesion and clarity.
	At each Annual Inspection the Annual Inspection Report is to have a statement "AD114 Issue 2 Action 2 not carried out. Aircraft operating under restricted envelope."

	2. Carry out the actions specified in GFA AD's 130 and 131. When this action is complete, the flight envelope may be restored to its original values and the restricted placard, ASI red mark and decal on the airspeed indicator can be removed.

Compliance, Compliance Time(s) and Frequency	Compliance with this Airworthiness Directive is mandatory and compliance, including action taken pursuant to this Airworthiness Directive must be recorded in the aircraft log book, annually. Action 1 is to be carried out before next flight. Action 2 is to be carried out no later than 1000 flying hours for serial numbers 11 to 25 and no later than 1500 flying hours for serial numbers 26 to 80.
